Timeline

27/01/2025, midnight — Application deadline

End of February — Pre-selection of applications by the selection committee (composed of the founder, artistic director, and qualified members of the Foundation)

24/03/2025 — Announcement of selected artists

Residency Framework

Montresso* Art Foundation's residency at Jardin Rouge is open to **visual artists** (drawing, painting, sculpture, and photography).

There are no restrictions based on nationality or age, but applicants must demonstrate a significant professional artistic background.

The residency duration is **between one and three months**. Artists may be invited to return to continue their research based on the initial project or to develop new projects in collaboration with the Foundation.

The Foundation's team communicates in English, Arabic, and French.

Support Provided

The Foundation provides **the technical, material, and financial** support necessary to complete the artist's project.

Montresso* Art Foundation will **finance the production** of the approved project, covering **transportation, meals, and all required materials**. The artist will be provided with a **private studio and accommodation** on the residency site.

In addition to tailored **human and technical support** throughout the residency, the Foundation offers opportunities for **local and international networking**.

The Foundation is open for visits by appointment and enjoys visibility both in Morocco and internationally.

Events organized within the Foundation and with various cultural and artistic partners provide artists with **multiple opportunities to present their work**.

Application Procedure

Residency workshops are assigned following a review by the selection committee, based on the relevance, quality, and feasibility of the proposed project at Jardin Rouge.

Applications must include the following documents :

Artistic Project Presentation :

Description of the project, techniques used, sketches, and estimated budget.
(Maximum 10MB PDF file)

Portfolio from the last 3 years :

maximum of 15 pages with captioned works.
(Maximum 10MB PDF file)

Biography :

400 characters, including spaces.
(Maximum 1MB PDF file)

CV :

(Maximum 1MB PDF file)

General Information Questionnaire completed via Google Forms

Please submit your application (in French or English) via **Google Forms**, in PDF format (e.g., name_surname_portfolio.pdf).

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
Applications sent via social media or the Foundation's email will not be taken into account.

Collaboration Terms

The residency is governed by a **collaboration agreement** signed between the artist and the Foundation.

Works created during the residency and approved by both parties may be offered for acquisition within the Foundation's spaces for a period of two years. The distribution of the sale price between the artist and the Foundation will be specified in the agreement. After this period, unless the artist requests the works be returned, they will remain on display for sale within the Foundation's spaces. Return shipping costs will be the responsibility of the artist.

In consultation with the artist, a selection of works created during the residency will be integrated into Montresso* Art Foundation's permanent collection. This collection aims to preserve a record of all the artists supported since the Foundation's creation, showcasing the diversity and richness of artistic practices over the years.
